Section 14: Pennsylvania Rabbits:

Requirements:

- 1. A statement of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship will be included on each registration form
- 2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.

Section 15: Out of State Rabbits:

Requirements:

- A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within the 60 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition is required.
- 2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI).
- 3. A statement of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship will be included on each registration form

Entry Fee - \$2.00 per rabbit. Non-refundable. Checks made out to Jefferson County Fair. **Breed of Rabbit must be listed on Entry Form.**

- 1. Entries will be received from 12:00 to 3:30 PM Sunday.
 - 2. All entry forms must be in the hands of the Livestock Chairperson on or before June 15. The entry fee of \$3 per head must accompany the entry form.
- 3. There will be a separate category for Mixed Breeds (Pets).
- 4. Exhibitors must provide their own feed.
- 5. All rabbits are to be judged according to the latest standards of perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
- 6. All pure-bred rabbits must have a PERMANENT EAR MARK
- 7. No rabbits will be bred during the Fair.
- 8. There will be Senior, Intermediate and Junior Classes in all breeds.
- 9. No rabbit may compete in more than one class.
- 10. Release time is 10 PM on Saturday.
