3	Arrangements in Pedestal Container	18	“Country Amish” – A basket or wooden box maybe used for this arrangement. The main colors and foliage should be shades of blues and purples, dried materials and/or fresh flowers and foliage and wooden accessories may be used.
4	Fruit or Vegetable Arrangement with or without flowers or foliage	19	“Wilderness Thicket” – dried and/or fresh materials from the woods and meadows, ie, vines, branches, pods, leaves, etc. in a rustic container.
