**SECTION 2 - HAY**  
**Premiums: \$3.00 \$2.00 \$1.00**

Long Hay only. An exhibit shall consist of a bale section at least eight inches thick or an equivalent amount if cut from in the mow. **PLACE BALE SECTIONS IN A BOX NO HIGHER THAN EIGHT INCHES THICK.**

**PLEASE**

- 1 Alfalfa or Alfalfa Grass mixed first cuttings, not over 50% of grasses.
- 2 Alfalfa or Alfalfa Grass mixed later cuttings, not over 50% of grasses.
- 3 Other Legumes or Legume Grass mixture, not over 50% of grasses.
- 4 Grass, first cutting, mixture of timothy and/or grasses containing not more than 10% legumes.
- 5 Grass, second cutting, mixture of timothy and/or grasses containing not more than 10% legumes.
- 6 Mixed Hay, any mixture not classified in the previous classes, but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination with alfalfa, timothy, clover or grasses.
- 7 Summer Annual Grasses, Sudan grass, Sorghum-Sudan, Hybrids, etc.
- 8 Grand Champion Hay Exhibit

**SECTION 3 - SILAGE**  
**Premiums: \$4.00 \$3.00 \$2.00**

Silage Crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of 10 pounds. Large-size plastic bags are excellent containers for transporting or showing samples.

**CLASS**

- 9 Perennial Crops, direct cut, with or without preservatives
- 10 Perennial Crops, wilted or low moisture, with or without preservatives.
- 11 Annuals other than Corn, direct cut, with or without preservatives.
- 12 Annuals other than Corn, wilted or low moisture, with or without preservatives.
- 13 Corn Silage

**SECTION 4 - BROOM CORN**  
**Premiums: 3.00 \$2.00 \$1.00**

- 14 Broom Corn, 1 bundle

Brooms - each exhibit shall consist of three brooms made of broom corn grown within the county:

- 15 Standard
