### HEALTH RULES FOR RABBITS

The Jefferson County Fair Authority adopts all Animal Health Requirements as outlined by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture (PDA) and makes all Animal Health Recommendations of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture **REQUIREMENTS** to exhibit at the Jefferson County Fair. The Jefferson County Fair Authority reserves the right to make changes based upon disease emergencies and information from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. Complete Health rules are posted on the Jefferson County Fair website at [www.jeffcofair.com](http://www.jeffcofair.com) It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to review the rules and provide the required information (this includes required identification, CVI, vaccinations, blood tests, etc.)

*Due to the concern of disease spread the Jefferson County Fair will not be accepting any rabbits that originate from outside the state of Pennsylvania or that have traveled outside of the state.*

- 1 All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.
- 2 An Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinary Consultation Relationship statement for the animals being exhibited must be included on the fair registration form.
- 3 A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued WITHIN 14 DAYS OF FAIR for Pennsylvanian rabbits.
- 4 A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 30 days prior to the date of importation for out of state rabbits.

**Entry Fee - \$5.00 per rabbit. -Meat pen entry \$7.00. Nonrefundable. Checks made out to Jefferson County Fair.**

***Breed of Rabbit must be listed on Entry Form.***

1. Entries will be received from 12:00 to 3:30 PM Sunday – first day of fair.
2. All entry forms and fees must be to the Jefferson County Fair on or before June 15.
3. There will be a separate category for Mixed Breeds (Pets).
4. Exhibitors must provide their own feed.
5. All rabbits are to be judged according to the latest standards of perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association. **JUDGING WILL BE MONDAY AT 8:00 AM**  
All exhibitors are responsible for knowing the time their shows will begin and being ready to enter the ring/show area prior to the start time. Those that are late may be disqualified at the discretion of the Judge and/or Superintendent.
6. All pure-bred rabbits must have a PERMANENT EAR MARK
7. No rabbits will be bred during the Fair.
8. There will be Senior, Intermediate and Junior Classes in all breeds.
9. No rabbit may compete in more than one class.
10. **RELEASE TIME WILL BE 12:10 A.M. ON SUNDAY MORNING following end of fair.**

- 4 Junior buck – 8 weeks to 5 months of age
- 5 Intermediate buck – 5 months to 8 months
- 6 Senior buck – 8 months and older
- 7 Doe with litter (kits must be at least 5 weeks of age)
- 15. Open Meat Pen (Does NOT sell at 4-H/Vocational Sale) three animals

**SECTION 2 – GRADE OPEN RABBITS**

Grade Premiums: \$5.00 \$4.00 \$3.00

**OPEN CLASSES**

- 8 Junior Doe - 8 weeks to 5 months of age
- 9 Intermediate doe – 5 months to 8 months
- 10 Senior doe – 8 months and older
- 11 Junior buck – 8 weeks to 5 months of age
- 12 Intermediate buck – 5 months to 8 months
- 13 Senior buck – 8 months and older
- 14 Doe with litter (kits must be at least 5 weeks of age)
- 16 Open Meat Pen (Does NOT sell at 4-H/Vocational Sale) three animals

**Class 1 Premiums 1<sup>st</sup> - \$10.00 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$5.00 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2.50**  
**1<sup>st</sup> place will receive special rosette**

Rabbit exhibitors who maintain the most attractive and sanitary exhibits will be eligible for special premiums. All Rabbit exhibits – both open and 4-H/Vocational - will be scored on the following basis:
