- 17 "Old Glory" – Main colors in this arrangement should be RED, WHITE AND BLUE, fresh flowers and foliage should be in a cup and saucer, Patriotic accessories maybe used.
- 18 "Country Amish" – A basket or wooden box maybe used for this arrangement. The main colors and foliage should be shades of blues and purples, dried materials and/or fresh flowers and foliage and wooden accessories may be used.
- 19 "Wilderness Thicket" – dried and/or fresh materials from the woods and meadows, ie, vines, branches, pods, leaves, etc. in a rustic container.
